

You need:

- Pink terry velour 50 x 50 cm (20" x 20")
- Light brown terry cloth 30 x 40 cm (12" x 16")
- Imitation fur in brown/ pink 30 x 40 cm (12" x 16")
- Scrap of dark brown terry cloth for the muzzle.
- Jersey in white and black for the eyes.
- White felt for the teeth.
- Matching sewing thread in white, pink, light brown, dark brown, and black.

- Marking pen
- Open toe appliqué foot, Part No: 820213-096
- Fusible web
- Embroidery stabilizer
- Sharp, pointed scissors
- Batting (to fill the bunny)

1 Paper pattern

The full-sized pattern, including seam allowances, can be found on the pattern sheet.

2 Cutting

- Terry velour:
- Body front, cut 1
- Body back, cut 1
- Light brown:
- Inner ear cut 2
- Belly, cut 1
- Imitation fur:
- Outer ear cut 2
- Tail, cut 1

Attention! When cutting the imitation fur, please note the following:

Draw the outline of the pattern piece on the wrong side of the fabric. Working from the wrong side of the fabric, carefully cut only the base fabric along the drawn outline. This ensures that the pile fibers are not cut and that they can later be teased out of the seam.

White felt:

Teeth cut 2

Appliqués:

Trace the outline of each appliqué piece onto the fusible web. Cut out each piece roughly. Iron each piece to the wrong side of the corresponding fabric cut out the pieces exactly.

For each piece, peel off the paper backing and iron the piece to the corresponding background fabric.

White:

Whites of eyes, cut 2

Black:

Pupils, cut 2

Dark brown:

Muzzle, cut 1

3 Sewing

Body front:

Iron the pieces for the eyes, muzzle, and belly to the body front piece, following the pattern.

Attach the Open toe appliqué foot on your sewing machines. Thread it with matching sewing thread. Lay stabilizer underneath.

Stitch around each appliqué piece with narrow satin stitch.

Use the marking pen to draw the mouth. Thread your sewing machines with black thread, stitch along the marked line with narrow satin stitch. Put the teeth in place and stitch.

Ears:

For each ear, lay outer ear piece on inner ear piece, right sides facing. Stitch together all around, leave an opening for turning. Turn right side out. Tease pile fibers out of side seams.

Body:

Lay the body front and body back pieces together, right sides facing. Stitch together along all edges, leaving openings for ears and turnings.

Turn the body right side out.

Fill the front section of each leg slightly. Use the marking pen to draw claws.

Stitch along these marked lines, using pink thread and straight stitch, length 2.0.

Fill legs entirely.

To give the bunny more structure, use straight stitch to stitch along lines where legs are attached to the body.

Fill paws and head. Stitch along lines where paws and head are attached to body.

Put the ears into seam opening. Sew openings closed by hand.

Turn allowance on tail piece to wrong side. Handsew tail to body back.

Now fill the body entirely, then close the seam opening by hand.
